

# Morse Code Challenge

## Before you can start:

The programme is quite old, programmed in the early 90s by Peter Young with GW-Basic. No colours, no fancy design, but still very popular at Jamborees, Radio Scouting events, JOTA.

It was available on the WOSM Webpage for decades, but unfortunately no longer.

Old computers and notebooks can be perfectly recycled for this programme. Operating systems Windows8 (32bit!) and older are suitable.

- 1.) Install a DOSBox, like the DOSBox0.74-win32-installer.exe
- 2.) Create a subdirectory morse for the root directory c:
- 3.) Copy the files GWBASIC.EXE, MORSE.BAT, MORSE.BAS and Score-start.txt to the subdirectory c:\morse
- 4.) Now your machine is ready for the challenge.
- 5.) Follow the staff instructions in the file Kander100\_Morse-Code-Challenge.pdf to run your activity.
